1. ENTRIES

All the riders (Prestige/Open, Junior, Youth) will have to pay an entry fee of 100 euros (transponder pack included) to the promoter. All entries must be received before 7 days prior the start of the Event. The entry fees for late entries will be 130 euros.

All entries must be made in writing by an “electronic” entry form available in the site www.superenduro.org.

All other information relating to the riders, team, sponsor and the brand of the machine shall be completed.

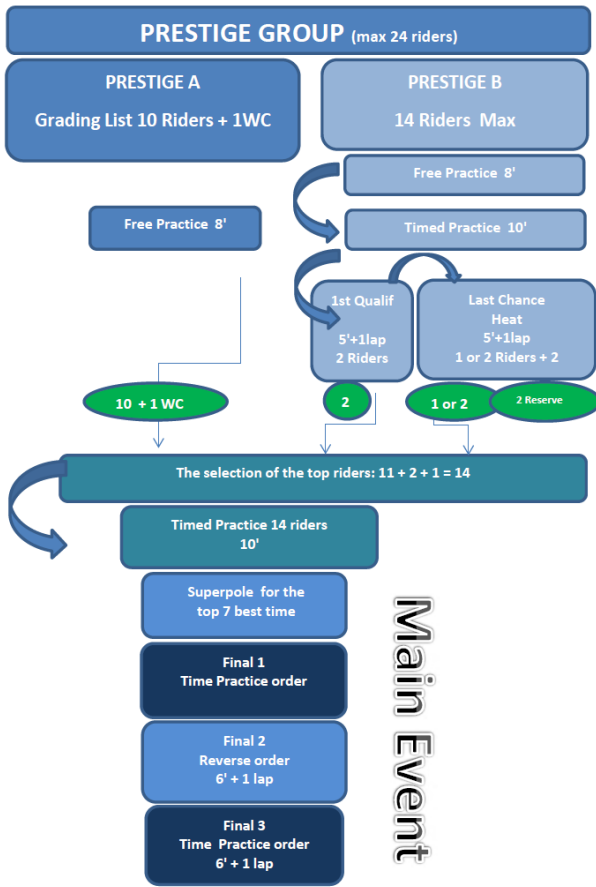

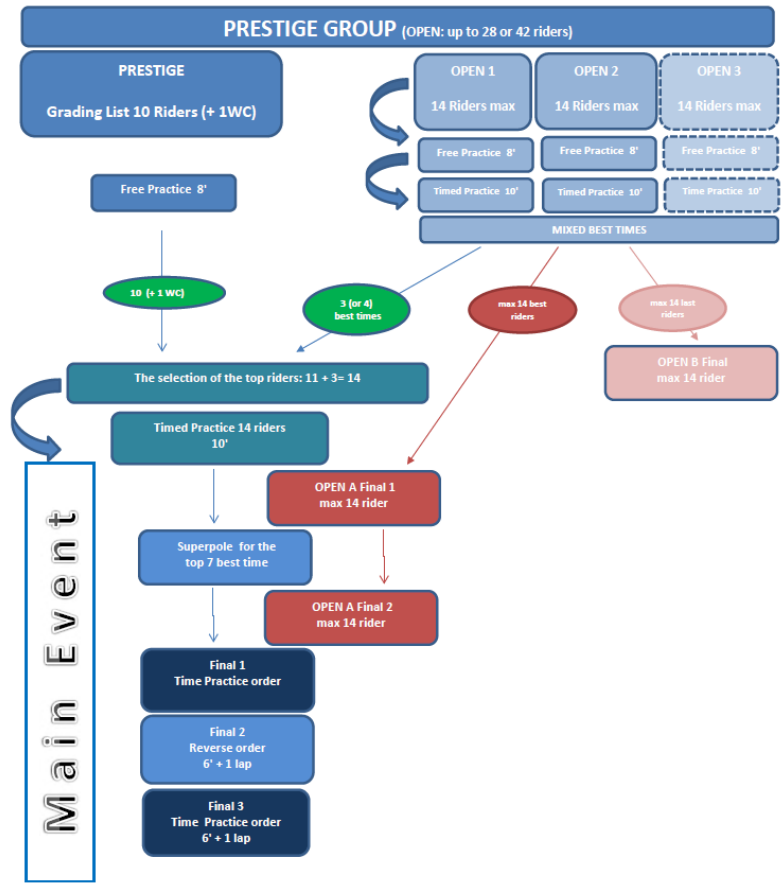


Race Format

Prestige:

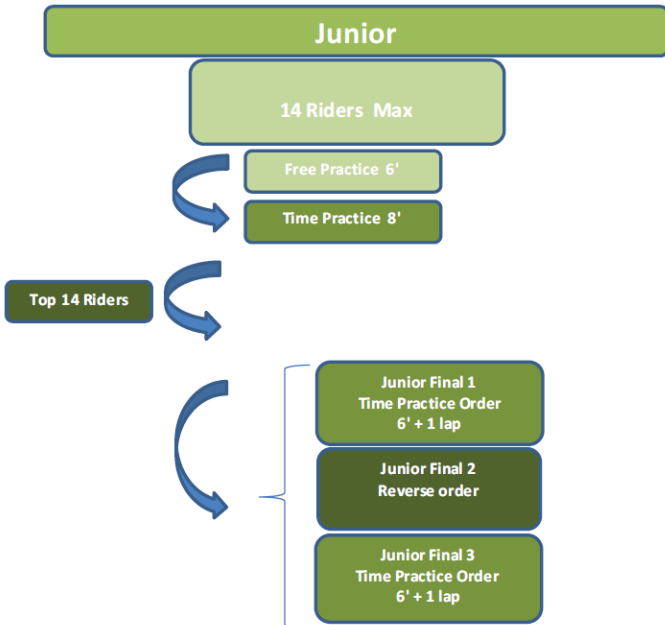


Prestige + Open:

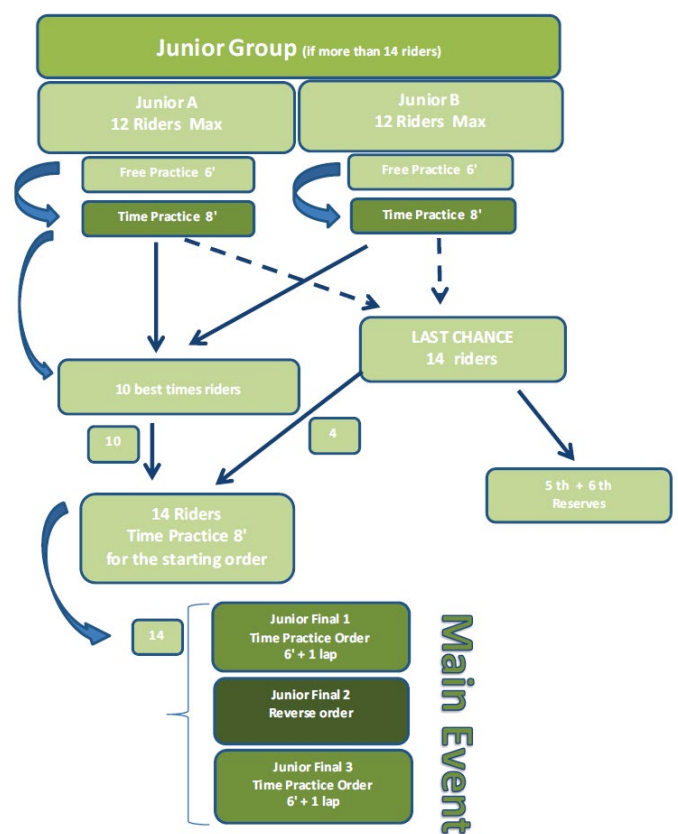


Juniors:

14 Riders Max

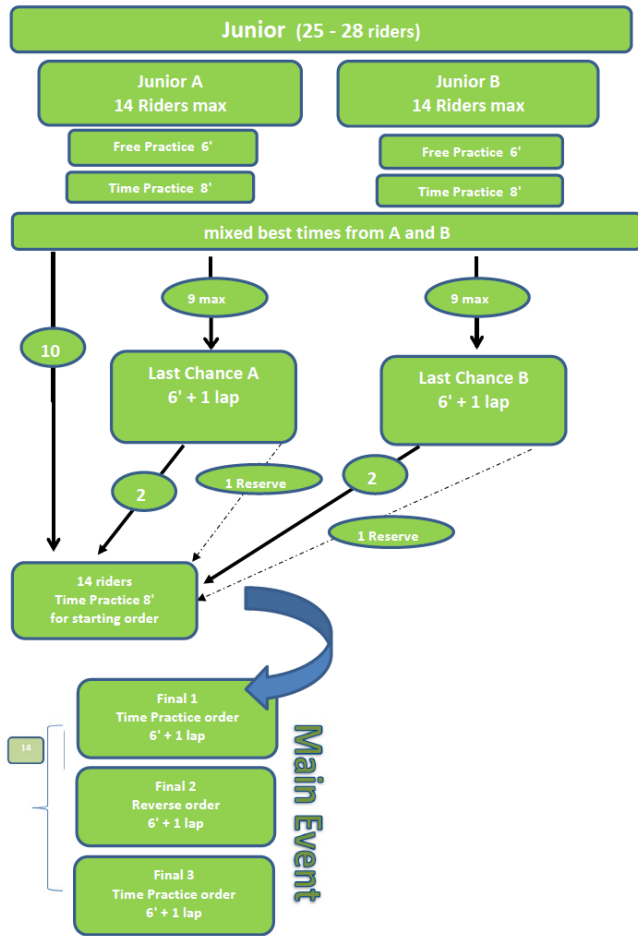

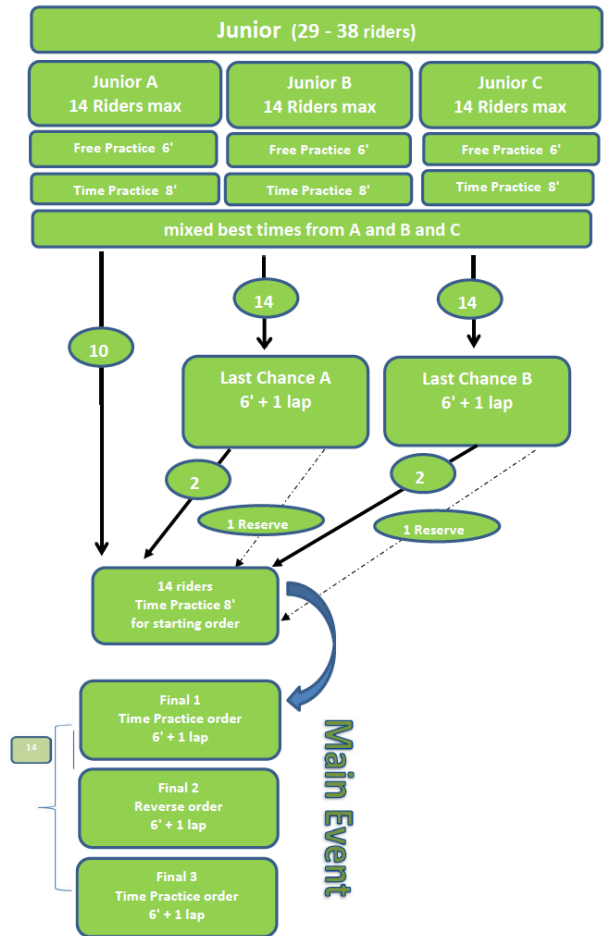




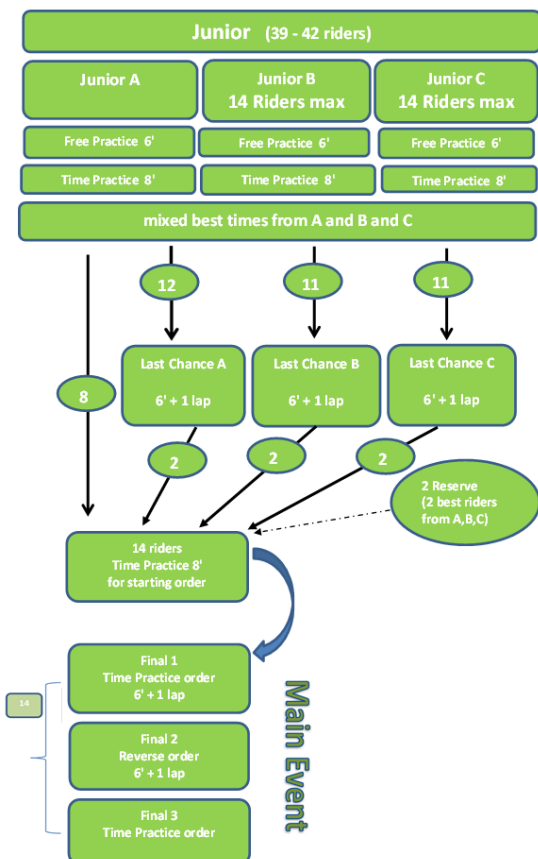
